Dear Applicant,

Your interest in the Blue Bird Circle is appreciated and your time and talent are needed. Please review the following information provided regarding The Blue Bird Circle. We hope The Blue Bird Circle will fit with your interest and time commitment requirements.

The Blue Bird Circle is a unique organization of women volunteering to support pediatric neurology. Through the revenue generated by its volunteer-run resale shop and other fundraising activities The Blue Bird Circle donates over \$1 million each year to support the Blue Bird Circle Clinic for Pediatric Neurology and The Blue Bird Circle Clinical Research Center at Texas Children's Hospital. We also support The Blue Bird Circle Developmental Neurogenetics Laboratory and The Blue Bird Circle Rett Center.

Membership includes several options. You may review the options below. Please fill out the application and return it to your Blue Bird Sponsor who will include a letter of recommendation for you and submit the application. You will be contacted and invited to come to The Blue Bird Circle Shop for an informational interview. Once the interview has taken place you will have an orientation along with a tour of the Shop and the Clinic and an assignment will be made. You will pay dues, receive a Blue Bird smock and will be added to the schedule at the Clinic or Shop as promptly as schedules allow. Your first days working will include training with an experienced Blue Bird or a team of Blue Birds.

Patricipal and Special Comparison

Active 1: 150 hours a year. Commit to at least two or more days a month volunteering in the shop and/or the clinic with an assigned role. Participate in special projects or committees. Regularly attend Blue Bird Circle membership meetings. All new members are presumed Active 1 unless they meet criteria specified for Active 2 or 3 which both require approval.

Active 2: 75 hours a year. Commit to at least one or more days a month volunteering in the Shop and/or Clinic with an assigned role. Participate in special projects or committees. Regularly attend membership meetings. Active 2 members may not hold a board position. Requests for Active 2 require approval and will be considered for those who are employed full time, are responsible for primary care of children, spouse or other relative.

Active 3: 50 hours a year or half a day a month. Commit to volunteering in the Shop, Clinic or through special projects such as event planning, social media or serving on a committee. Active 3 members may not hold a board position.

This category is only available under special circumstances and requires approval.

Monetary Commitment

Additional Provisional Membership Requirements

Attend an orientation and complete training for the service assignment agreed upon. Work the required hours for your membership category.

Participate in at least two Circle projects/fundraisers.

Attend the Know Your Clinic meeting and at least one other general meeting.

Blue Bird Volunteer Scheduling

The Volunteer hours are scheduled in bi-weekly segments. Volunteers commit to working a particular day of the week and are assigned either the first, third and fifth days of the month or the second and fourth days of the month.

The Shop is open from 10:00-4:00 Monday-Friday and 10:00-2:00 on Saturday. Your schedule will depend on which assignment you receive. Friday and Saturday volunteers get double hours.

The clinic volunteer hours are Monday-Friday 9:00-4:00. Friday volunteers get double hours.

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Projects are an important ancillary part of the Blue Bird Circle. They offer additional fundraising opportunities and wonderful fellowship with other Blue Birds.

Tea Towels, Baby Blankets, Boo Boo Bunnies are all projects that are lovingly hand-made by our members and sold in The Blue Bird Circle Shop.

Easter Eggs are a long-standing annual project that takes place in February in preparation for Easter sales with as many Blue Bird hands and friends of Blue Birds as possible to create hand painted unique eggs to sell in our shop and with selected retailers.

Easter Baskets are hand made by our members throughout the year by our members and serve as the perfect vehicle for the hand-made Easter Eggs.

The Spring Luncheon is our annual gathering for Blue Birds, friends and the community to raise funds, increase awareness of our goals and achievements and celebrate our Blue Bird Community.



Information for The Blue Bird Circle Membership

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- *The Circle fiscal year is from June 1-May 31.
- *New members are accepted two or three times a year.
- *All new member candidates must have a Blue Bird Circle Sponsor.
- *New member application packets are available in the First Vice President's Office and members will be notified of the availability by email and signs posted at the Circle Shop.
- *All New Member Applications must be turned in to the First Vice President's Office by the specified date.
- *Candidates will be informed of Interview/Get Acquainted Day and Orientation Day once their application has been received.
- *The Candidates are voted on by The Board of Directors and then become a Provisional member for one year.
- *The incoming Provisionals are introduced at a General Meeting generally in September and February.
- *Provisionals may begin training once they have observed at The Clinic and The Shop and they receive an assignment.

SECINSORING.

Every candidate requires a Blue Bird Circle member to sponsor them by writing a letter of recommendation and serving as a mentor during the applicant's provisional year.

BUIL BIRD CANDIDATE BEDUIREMENTS

Active I Provisional:

- *Attend Orientation Day
- *Attend a minimum of one supervised 2 hour visit at The Blue Bird Clinic and a minimum of 2 days working a shift in The Blue Bird Circle Shop prior to final service assignment.
- *Complete training once service assignment is made.
- *Work a minimum of 150 service hours at the Shop, Clinic, or on service projects.
- *Attend a minimum of two General Meetings including the Know Your Clinic Meeting.
- *Participate in at least two Circle projects or fundraisers.

Active II Provisional:

- *All the requirements mentioned for Active I except the minimum service hours will be 75.
- *Active II may not hold a board position and requests for Active II require approval and are considered for those employed full time, are responsible for primary care of children, spouse, or relative.
